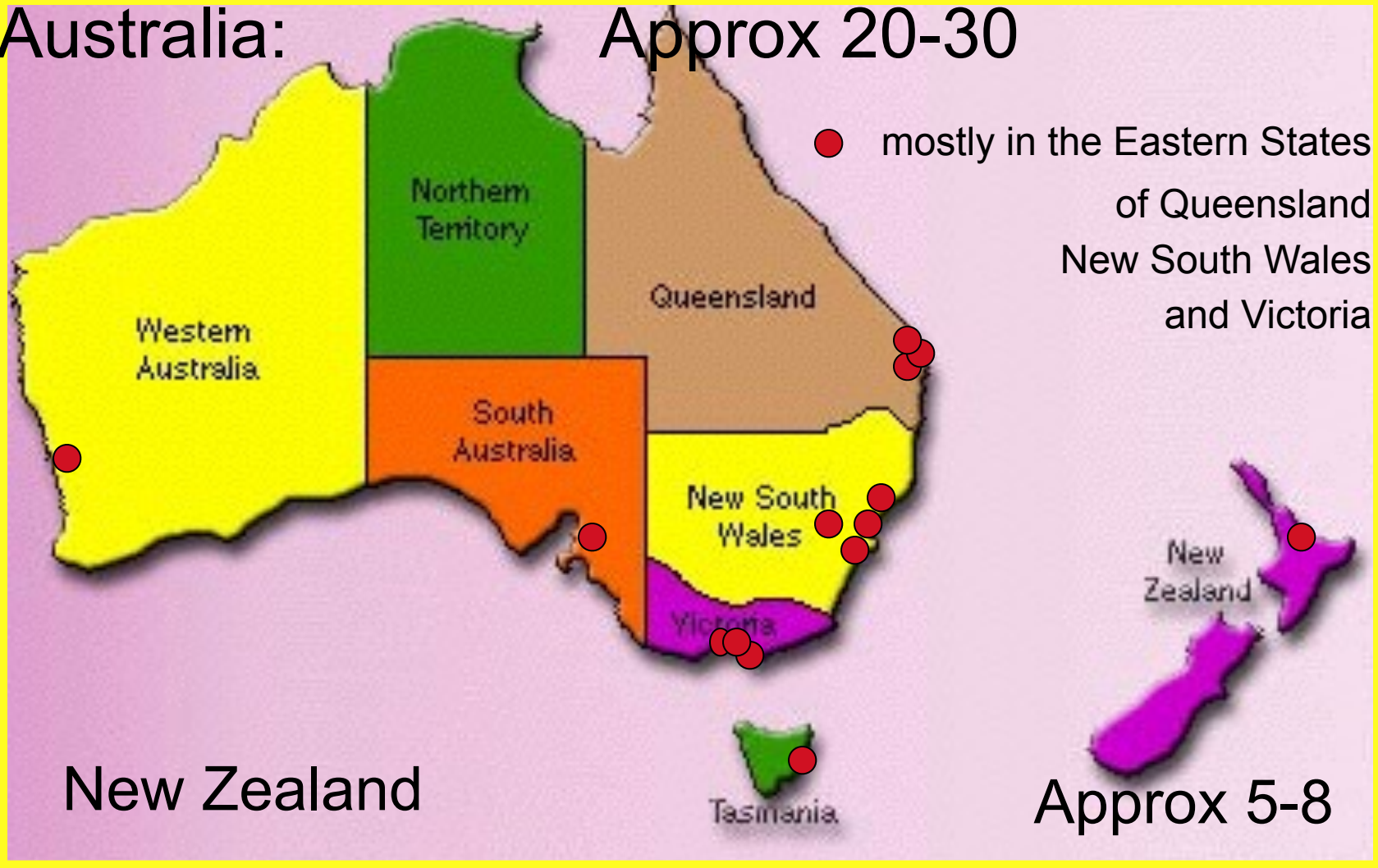

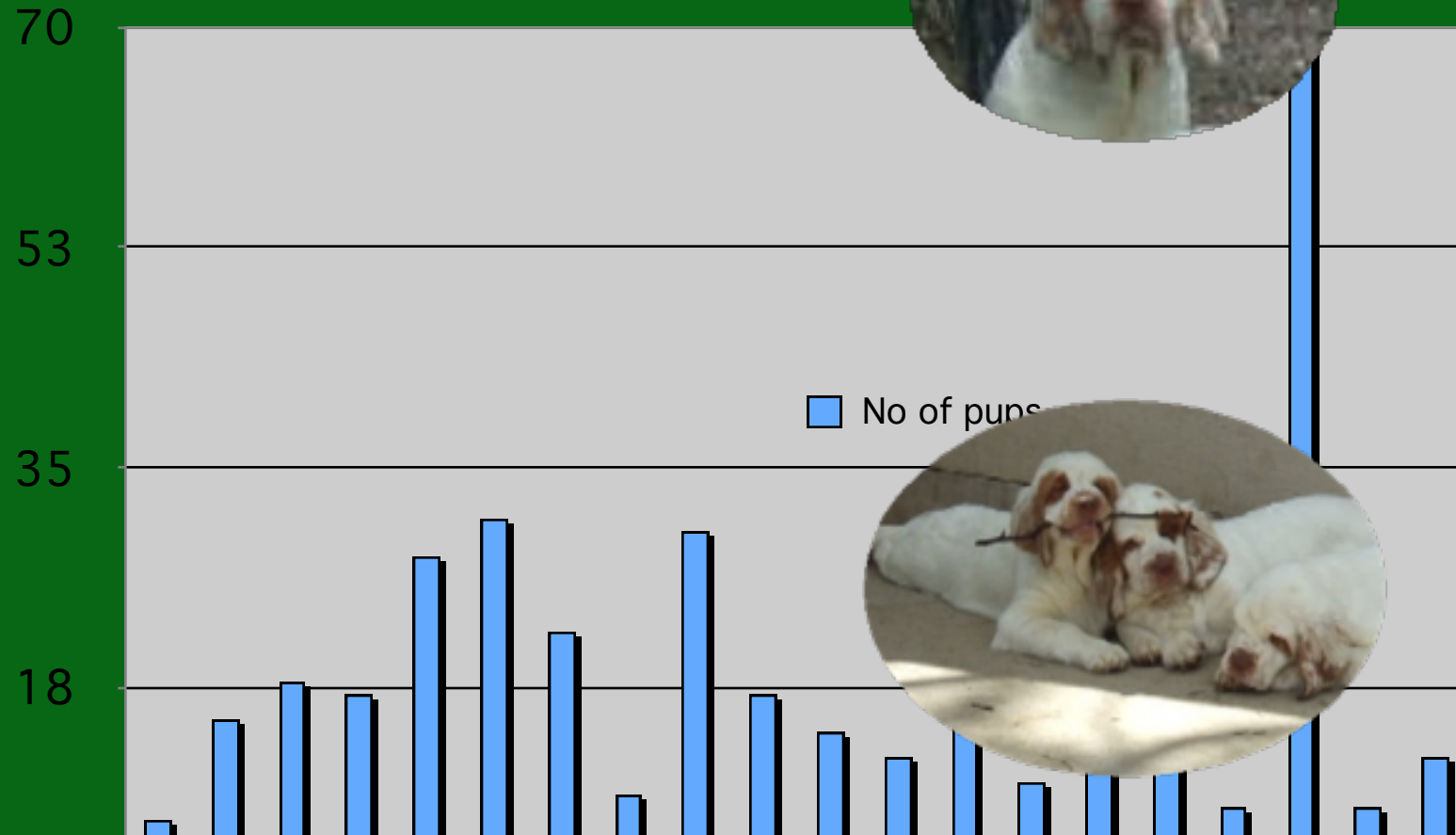

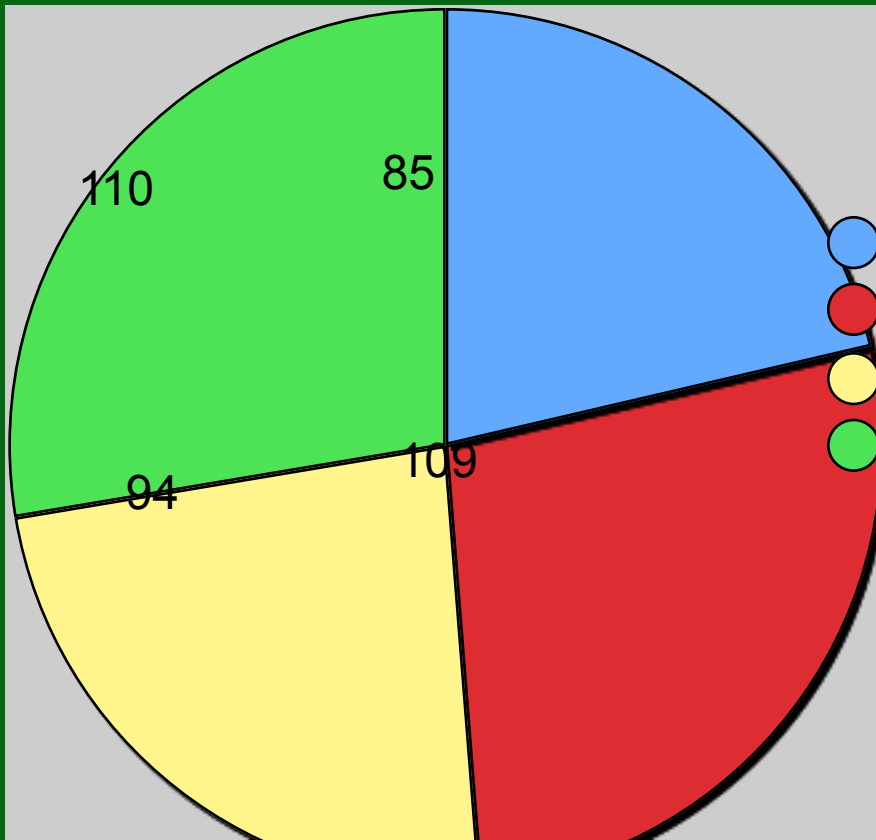




NUMBER OF PUPPIES OVER THE LAST 20 YEARS

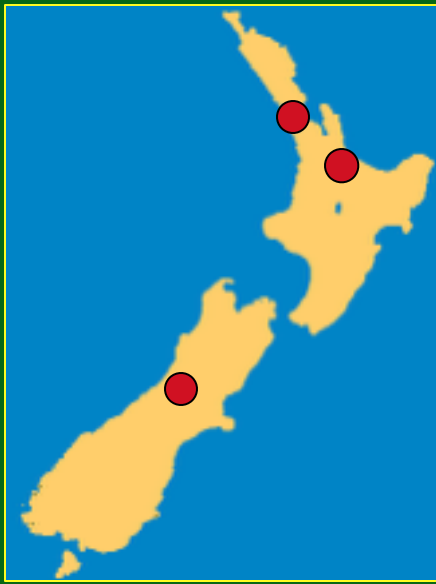

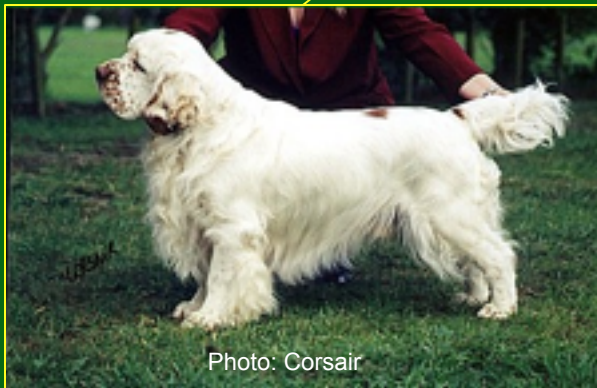

- The CSLV was formed in 1997
- Membership is approx 20 and growing
- Shows have been held since 2005 mostly with International judges
- Breeder and seller guidelines
- Code of Practice and Statement of Purpose
- formation of club web site www.erinrac.com/cslv

- The Club has designated members in most states who look after rescues, puppy placements, promotion, publicity, advice and breed issues. We endeavor to promote other successful exhibitors who may become long-term committed fanciers and breeders.
- Some members are involved in overseas clubs so that we may keep abreast of the relevant issues facing our breed

HEALTH ISSUES

THE CLUMBER SPANIEL LEAGUE OF VICTORIA HAS ADOPTED A CODE OF PRACTICE AND STATEMENT OF PURPOSE FOR VARIOUS HEALTH ISSUES.



encourages breeding only to improve the Clumber Spaniel's health levels and improve breed type as defined by the ANKC adopted breed standard



to take an active role in collating genetic information about our breed and keeping abreast with and disseminating information in relation to all health issues particularly associated with the Clumber Spaniel including support of The Clumber Spaniel Health Foundation and CRF (Canine Research Foundation from the ANKC) and The Canine Phenome Project

▶▶▶ P1 testing is well represented and the test is now available in Australia

▶▶▶ CERF (CERF) clinics are encouraged but not frequented enough

▶▶▶ Hip and Elbow x-rays are supported by some only because:

- No National Scheme. We adopted BVA scheme for German Shepherds
- Risk of anesthetic
- Cost

JUDGING OUR CLUMBERS

Australia now has a National Judges Training Scheme, run by the Australian National Kennel Council (ANKC), which implements consistency of training across all states.

This Program is designed to assist members of an ANKC Member Body to become Championship Show Judges by graduating through specific stages of training applicable to Aspiring Judge, Trainee Judge and ultimately, Championship Show Judge.

Clumbers are judged according to the Breed Standard adopted from the English Kennel Club plus the Breed Standard Extension (drawn up by the CSLV) which is included in a handout.



JUDGING OUR CLUMBERS



ASPIRING JUDGES MUST:

- ✓ Be 18 years or over
- ✓ Member of their State Body for 10 years
- ✓ Bred at least 3 litters and 2 champions under their own prefix
- ✓ Undertaken at least 2 years of training as a Steward
- ✓ Demonstrate an active participation in dog clubs

- ✓ Attend and pass all lectures on Theory Examinations of Rules and Regulations, Anatomy, Glossary of Terms, Judging Procedures and Show Management

- ✓ Attend and pass all breed lectures and practical examinations

- ✓ Provide written critiques for all practical examinations which consist of a minimum of 5 dogs and 5 bitches over 6 months of age.

- ✓ Attend several specialist shows in the year of application.

OUR CHALLENGES

- Cost of importing new dogs
- Lack of imported bitches
- Convincing breeders to send quality imports
- Small number of quality dogs presently available in ANZ
- Small numbers of fanciers and breeders
- Better judge education
- National hip scoring
